Heart Morass Wetlands Inspection Followed By Watermark Inc Annual General Meeting Monday 30th November 2009

We are delighted to be able to confirm the very interesting program leading up to our AGM.

At 4.30 pm IN THE WATERMARK OFFICE, ROOM 16 AT THE ADULT COMMUNITY EDUCATION CENTRE, RAYMOND STREET SALE, representatives from the Aboriginal Affairs Office, Bairnsdale will provide an audio visual presentation detailing aboriginal cultural heritage factors of significance and interest located within areas such as the Heart Morass Wetlands.

At 5.15 the meeting will adjourn to **the Heart Morass for a field expedition** (5.30 pm) during which Gunnai-Kurnai aboriginal representatives will highlight other very interesting issues of an aboriginal cultural heritage nature that may need to be taken into account in future restoration and rehabilitation works and projects.

This field expedition will be followed by a presentation by John Caldwell, Executive Officer of the Bug Blitz Trust detailing their many educational related programs which have been detailed in previous newsletters.

At 7.00 pm a brief Annual General Meeting will take place also at the Heart Morass site, simply turn off the South Gippsland Highway and follow the signs to the Swing Bridge.

Please take this opportunity to learn of and witness the many rehabilitation projects underway and inspect this unique wetlands area – which will undoubtedly become a project of national significance and importance.
